### Applicant eligibility:

All applicants **must** meet the following requirements

- Have an endorsement letter from a profit -to-member fund or a sponsoring organisation
- Be an Australian citizen or permanent resident
- Application are also open to directors appointed since January 1, 2018
- Have a current passport and be available to travel overseas in late May, early June 2020

**NB:** ACTU office holders, AIST staff and directors, and IFM employees are ineligible to apply.

- Obtain a letter of endorsement from someone you have worked for or other directors on boards you may sit on.

There are 4 scholarships in total and they will provide a variety of knowledge and skills-based training in getting you ready to become a director and board ready.

Some of the activities offered as part of the Garry Weaven Emerging Trustee Scholarship program include:

- Enrolment in the Harvard University Trustee Leadership Forum with ACTU delegation, being held at Harvard University, Cambridge, Boston, USA in 2020
- Attendance at the ACTU Super Trustees Forum and Scholarship Graduation & ACTU Congress in the years it runs (held every three years)
- Enrolment in the AIST Trustee Director Course
- Allocation of a suitable mentor
- Membership of AIST in the year of the scholarship
